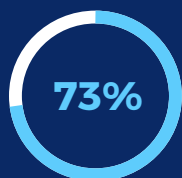

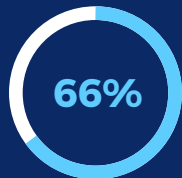

Your employees don't always get the support they need

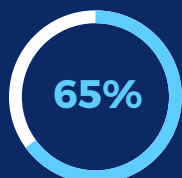
An OncoHealth survey of individuals with cancer showed:

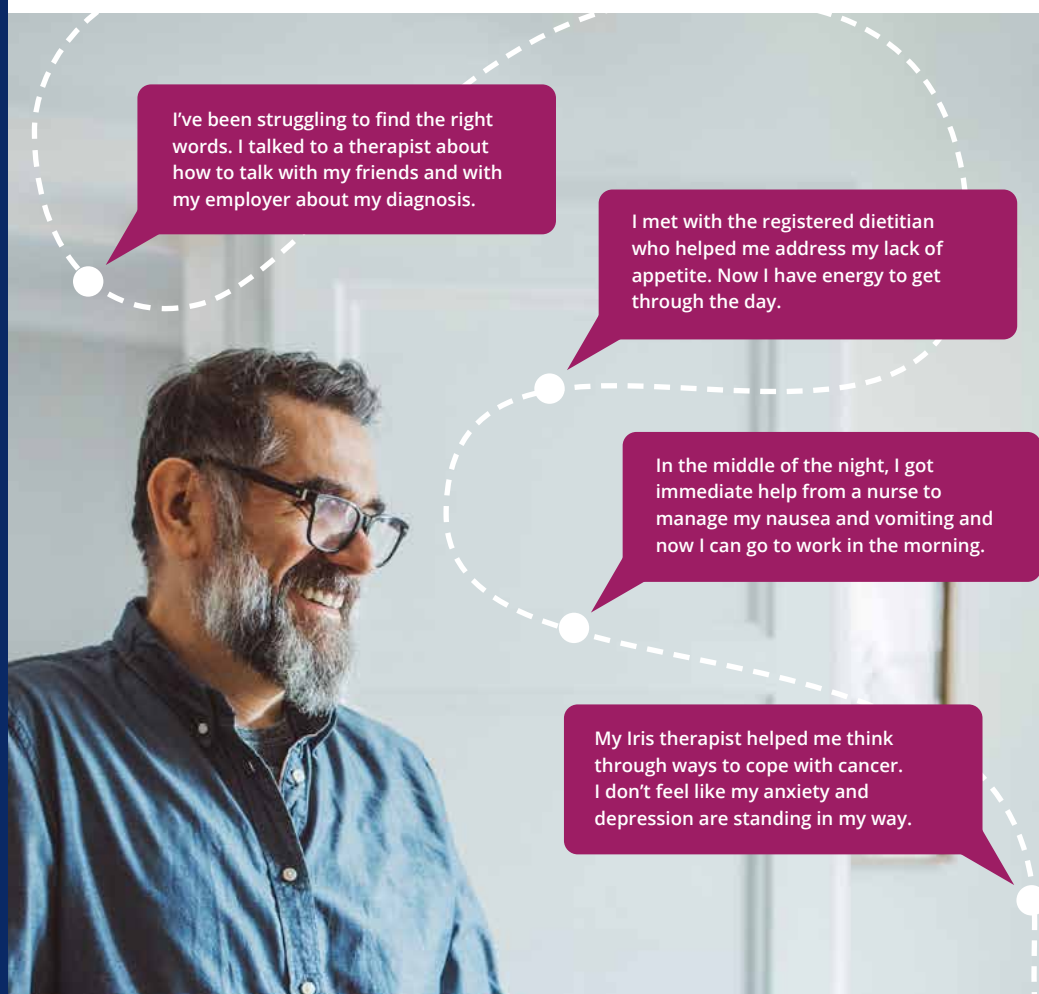
